Then incredible plans for some of the most unique luxury villas ever built in Las Vegas began rolling in. And for the very, very top of the building, a remarkable idea came in from one of the town's oldest friends, the publisher of Playboy magazine.

The Hugh Hefner Sky Villa cost almost \$5M to build. In building Hef's place, there was no intention of leaving anything to your imagination.

Like the personal glass elevator to the villa. When the door opens, the first thing you see is a remarkable collection of art on the walls, selected personally by Hugh Hefner. Next your eyes move to the outdoor cantilevered Jacuzzi with glass end walls and the familiar Playboy logo looking out across the Vegas skyline. Water is also flowing from an indoor Italian-tiled waterfall that rises from a reflection pond.

Floor to ceiling glass can leave you feeling like Hef's villa is even larger than its actual 9000 sq ft. The warm tones of the interior walls come from natural stone finishes imported from India and China. There's a dining room, a living room with fireplace, a full bar, a spa-style treatment room, a fully equipped gym and sauna, plus a media room with multiple plasma TVs. Since its Vegas, there's even a poker table.

And then there's the bedroom. Not

surprisingly, the master bedroom features the signature Hefner 8' rotating, round bed. And yes, of course there's a mirror on the ceiling!

The Hugh Hefner Sky Villa is so far over the top that it's where Kanye West held court at MTV's 2007 Video Music Awards—and invited Common, Soulja Boy and T-Pain over to live the good life. West and the folks at MTV searched to find a location that was absolutely, indisputably so sui generis that it made all other possibilities pale. This is where they landed.
