
### **Cultural Crossroads**

The Hughes House Bed and Breakfast is a Queen Anne-style house, which was once part of the Hammond town founder's estate. Or for an early 20th-century setting, book a room at Country Lane Bed & Breakfast, built in 1938 by the current owner's father and situated on 300 acres of land with a home built from lumber milled from pine timber harvested on the property.
